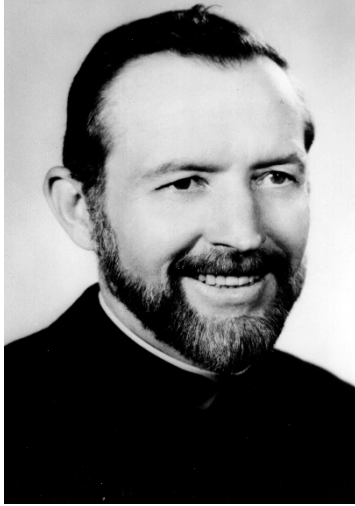


Bl. Stanley Rother Pilgrimage Guide

The First Annual Feast Day of Blessed Stanley Rother: July 28, 2018

Pilgrimage Sites

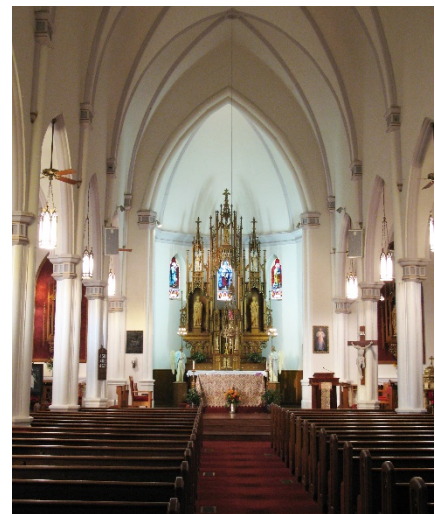
1. Holy Trinity Catholic Church

Address: 211 Missouri Ave., Okarche 73762

Holy Trinity Catholic Church was the home parish of Blessed Stanley Rother. This is the church where Blessed Stanley worshipped with his family, where he served Mass as an altar boy, and where he celebrated his First Mass as a priest.

The church is open daily from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. A display case in the back of the church contains personal artifacts of Bl. Stanley. Pilgrims are also invited to pray, light a votive candle, and deposit prayer intentions at the first-class relic that was used at his beatification ceremony. Tours of the church may be scheduled by calling the parish office at (405) 263-7930.

The parish has a new gift shop with religious goods and souvenirs. It is open Monday-Wednesday from 10:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m., Saturday at 6 p.m., and Sunday at 11:30 a.m. Also, Eischen's, famous for its chicken, is a five-minute walk from the church.

2. Heritage Gallery

Located inside the Catholic Pastoral Center, the Heritage Gallery tells the story of Blessed Stanley Rother: “The Shepherd Cannot Run.”

The Heritage Gallery is open Monday-Friday from 8:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. During the month of July, the Heritage Gallery will be open on some weekends to facilitate pilgrimages:

- Saturday, July 14: 9:30 a.m. - 11:30 a.m.
- Sunday, July 15: 2 p.m. - 4 p.m.
- Saturday, July 21: 9:30 a.m. - 11:30 a.m.
- Sunday, July 22: 2 p.m. - 4 p.m.

3. Resurrection Memorial Cemetery Chapel

Address: 7801 Northwest Expressway; 7500 W. Britton Rd.

The Resurrection Memorial Chapel contains the crypt of Blessed Stanley. The chapel is open Monday - Friday from 8:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.

During the month of July, the chapel will be open on some weekends to facilitate pilgrimages:

- Saturday, July 14: 9:30 a.m. - 11:30 a.m.
- Sunday, July 15: 2 p.m. - 4 p.m.
- Saturday, July 21: 9:30 a.m. - 11:30 a.m.
- Sunday, July 22: 2 p.m. - 4 p.m.
