

Blessed Stanley Rother Peg Dolls

- ❖ Print a color pattern for either a 3 ½" or 2 ¼" wooden peg doll.
- ❖ Using a black sharpie, draw the smile, eyes and an upside down "u" for the face.
- ❖ Using brown acrylic paint, paint the hair and beard on the face.
- ❖ Cut out the patterns and cut small slits around the neck so that the paper will lay flat as you glue around the neck.
- ❖ Using a tacky craft glue, attach the pattern around the doll making sure to line up the hands with the face.
- ❖ After drying, apply two coats of "Mod Podge".
